Dear Sir or Madam:

On the reverse side is a Hazardous Waste Fee Form for determining fees due for hazardous waste handling activities during calendar year 2002. The Iowa Code requires that this form be completed and that fees be paid by anyone required to obtain a US Environmental Protection Agency hazardous waste identification number. You are receiving this form because EPA assigned hazardous waste identification number **IAD157513086** to your facility.

This form must be completed, signed, and returned to the department by April 15, 2003 even if you do not owe a fee or EPA assigned the ID number in error. A 15% penalty will apply to all fees received after the April 15 deadline.

If you are an authorized agent of the "federal government" or the "state of Iowa or any of its political subdivisions" you are exempt from payment of fees.

The Hazardous Waste Fee is sometimes confused with the Household Hazardous Materials Permit Fee. The Hazardous Waste Materials Permit Fee is for a permit that is required of all retailers that sell household hazardous materials to consumers. The Hazardous Waste Fee is a fee on the generation, transportation, treatment, storage and disposal of waste that is hazardous.

Definitions of "waste", "hazardous waste", "hazardous waste generator" and examples of hazardous waste generated by small businesses are enclosed.
